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## A brief profile **Turning Point Foundation**

Established in 2000 and registered in 2002, Turning Point Foundation is a charitable organization aimed at intervening the issues related to health, education and livelihood to the hard to reach and disadvantaged group of population in our society. For this purpose, presently the organization is running two different projects in Delhi

1. **Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts (IRCA)**, supported by Government of India located at Alipur, North Delhi). Indoor treatment facilities are provided to the people who dependent on drugs, alcohol or related addictive substances.
2. **Youth Resource Centre (YRC)** supported by MDSOG, at LalBagh, North Delhi. The goal of the project is to provide knowledge and skills for young vulnerable people to earn a reasonable living so that they are not at risk of being drawn into unsafe social and unhealthy behaviours. The project also impart skill development to match their needs or immediate requirements for youths from disadvantaged sections of the society.

## Ongoing Activities of Youth Resource Centre

1. **Digital Unify Programme (ICB):** The Informatics and Computer Basics (ICB) course within the Digital Unify Programme is composed of five modules and covers basic understanding of MS Office and Internet tools and their usage, and responsible of use of Information and Communication Technology. Digital Unify Programme is designed and conducted in partnership with STMicroelectronics Foundation, India.



2. **Digital Unify Programme (ICB-Advanced):** Advanced skills in MS word, Excel and PowerPoint is imparted through this course



3. **Basic Computer Course:** This is a basic course having a curriculum for 4 months where Microsoft word, Excel, PowerPoint and internet usage is taught.



4. **Basic English:** For students who are weak in English and studying in schools. Many students were able pick up with their school curriculum after learning basics of English.



5. **Sewing and Cutting:** The course is of six months duration and each day is having five batches per day at two different centres. Each batch has 1.30 hours of training time every day.



6. **Informal Education (Basic Hindi):** Many children who are attending schools and adult ladies who lacks basics of Hindi and that is why they are finding difficult to continue their school studies. The course will enable them to set basics of Hindi language and continue their studies.



7. **Menstrual Health & Hygiene Sessions:** Menstrual Health & Hygiene in collaboration with Group of Friends Welfare Trust (GoFWT), Delhi community adolescence and women in batches.
8. **In-house sessions on health & Life Skills:** YRC is also providing health education including Personal Hygiene, reproductive health, HIV/AIDS & Drug abuse awareness along with Life skills education. The aim of these sessions is to enable the young people to have informed choices in their life decisions.
9. **Career Guidance and support:** YRC provides various information on career guidance, school/college admissions, job hunting and other information to make a suitable choice for their future. YRC also play as a facilitation centre for young people who want to access internet to avail various schemes/application process for educational support.
10. **Celebration of National, Social and Cultural Events:** These occasions are made use of recreation and improving bonds among youth as well as to impart knowledge about various subjects.
